Insight RE Assessment Framework

The Insight RE Assessment Framework provides primary schools with a clear and manageable approach to assessing pupils' learning in Religious Education from Years 1–6.

Developed for Insight by Wendy Harrison of WH Training & Consultancy Ltd, the Framework is **curriculum-neutral and designed to work alongside any agreed syllabus or existing RE curriculum**. Schools can therefore retain what they currently teach while strengthening progression and consistency in assessment.

The framework is built around four concepts that run throughout the primary years:

Beliefs • Community • Expression • Sacred

For each year group, progression statements — shown as learning objectives within Insight — support **formative assessment** and help teachers identify what pupils are expected to learn. These are complemented by **summative judgement statements**, enabling teachers to make best-fit judgements about whether pupils are Working Towards expectations, working at the Expected Standard or demonstrating Greater Depth.

Progression is carefully structured from description and recognition in Year 1 through to analysis, evaluation and reasoned conclusions by Year 6. The framework supports the assessment of both substantive and disciplinary knowledge while avoiding unnecessary recording and tracking.

The full guidance includes year-by-year expectations, concept progression, judgement statements, exemplar assessment tasks, pupil responses and teacher commentary.
